Spreading Dummy's Hand (Law 41D)

- ♠ Placed in front of player
 - Sorted into suits,
 - ♥ Faced up in columns pointing towards declarer,
 - **♥** Ranked with lowest towards declarer.
 - Trumps are placed to Dummy's right.
- Declarer plays both his hand and dummy's.

Dummy's Rights and Limitations (Laws 42, 43 and 45F)

- ♠ Dummy plays the cards of the dummy as declarer's agent as directed (Law 42A.3).
- ♠ Dummy may keep count of tricks won and lost in accordance with Law 65B (Law 42A.2).
 - ▼ Tricks won are pointed lengthwise toward the partner (Law 65B.1).
 - ▼ Tricks lost are pointed lengthwise towards the opponents (Law 65B.2).
 - Declarer may require a card pointed incorrectly to be corrected (Law 65B.3).
 - Defenders and Dummy may do so only for the current trick, but not after play to the next trick (Law 65B.3).
 - ♣ If done after the current trick, then Law 16 Unauthorized Information applies (Law 65B.3).
- ▲ Dummy may give information; however, may not obtain information:
 - ▶ May try to prevent an irregularity by declarer. (Law 9A.3 and Law 42B.2).
 - If any irregularity occurs, may not call attention to during play (Law 42B.3 and Law 43A.1(b)).
 - ♦ May do so after play has been concluded (Law 42B.3 and Law 43A.1(a)).
 - ♣ Should not initiate a call for the Director during play unless another player has stated an irregularity has occurred (Law 43A.1(a)).
 - ♣ May do so after play is concluded (Law 43A.1(a)).
 - May ask declarer whether he has a card in the suit when he has failed to follow suit.
- ♠ Dummy may not participate in the play or communicate anything about the play to the declarer (Law 43A.1(c))
 - **♥** May not exchange hands with declarer. (Law 43A.2(a)).
 - ♥ May not leave his seat to watch declarer's play (Law 43A.2(b)).
 - May not on his own initiative look at the face of a car in either defender's hand (Law 43A.2(c)).
- **♦** Dummy indicates card (Law 45F)
 - Dummy may not touch or indicate a card, except to arrange, without instruction from declarer.
 - If so, the Director should be summoned and informed of the action.
 - Play continues to completion.
 - A Director shall award an adjusted score if he considers the defenders were damaged by the suggestion.
- ♦ Violations of Law 43A by Dummy
 - May result in procedural penalties and other rectifications may apply to the benefit of the defenders.
