The new site presents a large amount of information on a single page with links to other information on separate pages.

▼ If you have trouble reading, hold down the "Contl" key and move the roller on the mouse to enlarge the font size for your readability.

The home page has:

- ♦ Years: 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 in the upper right. You can see results at the club level for 2011 and 2012. As the web progresses information appears that tournament information may be entered for years 2014 and 2015.
- ♠ Tool bar: Home, Club, Unit Board, Kibitzer, Member Directory, Resources. These have drop down menus offering you further options.
- ♦ Welcome: describing what this new site has to offer you, particularly by logging in and registering where you will be able to see your scores and if any masterpoints for the last five games that you played.
- ▲ Local Tournament Trail: This gives name of the tournament location and dates including links to a new page for the maps and flyers. The maps show up in the Welcome area of the Home page and the flyers on a new webpage which when closed you are back to the Home page.
- ♦ Calendar of Events: Various tournaments are highlighted in colors which I see as dark blue being a regional, light blue as sectional and a light green as a STaC.
