♥ Oct 10th Monday Club Appreciation Open Pairs:

This game has 81.8% sectionally rate black point. As special thanks to you for supporting the club on Monday evenings, we will be serving pizza. Please let me know via email, telephone or signing up at the game by pairs, no later than Wednesday Oct 5th if you will be attending so that I know how much food to order. A sign-up sheet is available at the game Monday. Probable event timing is serving by 5:45 pm with eating in the main dining area so that the playing area may set-up, and game to start by 6:30 pm with number of boards to be determined.
