## Pass out of Turn

Left-hand-opponent has declined to accept the **Pass out of Turn**.

### ♠ Before any Call, Law 30.A

♥ A player in any position who passes before Dealer has a chance to call; this offender must pass only at his first turn to call. In addition Law 23 may apply.

### ♠ After a Bid, Law 30.B

♥ At offender's

♦ Right-hand-opponent's (RHO) turn to call; the offender must pass at his next turn to call. Law 23 may apply.

♦ Partner's turn to call, the offender must pass whenever it is his turn to call. Law 23 may apply.

♣ Offender's partner may make any sufficient bid or pass, but may not double or redouble at this turn

♦ Left-hand-opponent's (LHO) turn to call, this pass is treated as a change in call and Law 25 applies.

### ♠ The PASS is Artificial or of an artificial call, Law 30.C

♥ The pass is treated as a Bid out of Rotation, Law 31:

♦ His partner must pass, whenever it is his turn to call.

♦ Lead restriction may apply

## Bid out of Turn

Left-hand-opponent has declined to accept the **Bid out of Turn**.

### ♠ At offender's RHO's turn to call, Law 31.A:

♥ RHO passes: the offender repeats the legal bid with no further restrictions.

♥ RHO bids, doubles, or redoubles:

♦ The offender repeats the denomination at a sufficient level; the partner must pass at his next turn to call. Law 23 may apply.

♦ The offender DOES NOT repeat the denomination; his partner must pass whenever it is his turn to call.

♣ Lead restriction may apply

### ♠ At offender's Partner's or LHO's turn to call Law 31.B

♥ The offender has NOT previously called; his partner must pass whenever it is his turn to call.

♦ Law 23 and lead restriction may apply.

♥ The offender has previously called, this Bid is treated as a change in call and Law 25 applies.

## Awareness of Potential Damage Law 23

Whenever, in the opinion of the director, an offender could have been aware at the time of his irregularity that this could well damage the non-offending side, the director shall require the auction and play to continue (if not completed). When the play has been completed, the director awards an adjusted score if he considers the offending side has gained an advantage through the irregularity.
