North American Pairs 2022-2023 Club and District 13 Level

♦ Qualifications:

- Club level is open to both members and non-members and may be earned at any club in any unit in any district. A player may qualify as often as desired and with as many different partners as desired. Players qualify individually.
- For pairs of mixed Flights qualifying, the higher Flight player determines the qualifying Flight with the lower Flight player being eligible for both Flights at the next level when a choice must be made; e.g. a Flight A and Flight C pair qualify, at the next stage Flight A is limited to Flight A, but a Flight C may play in Flight A, B or C.
- ▶ District level: must have qualified at the club level, be a member of the district (principal residence in District 13 as of June 1, 2022), be eligible for the player's chosen flight, and be a paid member of the ACBL in good standing. A fixed amount prize will be awarded in all flights. There have been monetary awards for the District's finalist in the past. I could not verify them for this year.
- A Beyond the District final stage, a replacement is permitted only if one member of a pair that qualified to play in the National Final stage is either deceased or medically diagnosed unable to travel or play. Unable to travel to the National Final due to COVID-19 restrictions. Per ACBL policy, all players at the NABC must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Lack of vaccination does not constitute grounds for replacement under this provision.

▲ Masterpoints:

- Club qualifying games Open pairs: 50/50 red and black; Invitational pairs: all black points.
- ♥ District finals award gold for section firsts and overalls. Flight C is 25% gold for overalls. Other masterpoints in all flights are red.

Strata for Our Club Games and District Finals:

 \checkmark Flight A is unlimited; Flight B is limited to 0-2500 masterpoints; Flight C is limited non-life masters with less than 500 masterpoints.

♦ Games:

- ♥ Each club session may hold two games per month during June, July and August for qualifying players.
- District 13 final is a two-session event to be determined.
