The website has the following features:

- 1. Home page:
 - a. A short repeating slide show from the games which is intended to be changed monthly.
 - b. Basic information of where and time of the games with a hyperlink on Ann Sather to detailed instructions for getting to the games in the area
 - c. A menu bar listing: Home, About the Games, Bridge Articles, Monday Open Pairs, and Wednesday I/N Pairs.
 - d. The next upcoming games for both Monday and Wednesday with the cost per player.
 - e. Links to the ACBL and CCBA websites are listed.
- 2. About the Games
 - a. As the mouse hovers over the heading there is a menu for Contacts, Directions, and History; however if you click on the main heading there is a Welcome Letter.
 - b. Contacts has information for contacting club management.
 - c. Directions shows a map as well as having a link to a Google map
 - d. History has an article about the club and some highlights of recent years.
- 3. Bridge Articles
 - a. As the mouse hovers over the heading there is a menu for Bidding, Newsletters, and Play of the Hand; however if you click on the main heading there is an explanation of what is intended for this area.
 - b. Bidding has a couple of articles
 - c. Newsletter has the newsletters for 2013.
 - d. Play of Hand currently has no articles.
- 4. Monday Open Pairs
 - a. As the mouse hovers over the heading there is a menu for Deals, Results, and Schedule; however if you click on the main heading there is information about the Monday games.
 - b. The Deals and Results have the latest games listed first with the Deals being the same as the hand record sheets after the game. The Results has the recap of all players followed by each board showing the deal and the results by the players at each table; and I hope to add the actual contract at each table in the near future.
 - c. Schedule shows all games for both Monday and Wednesday with color code rating of the games according to masterpoint award computation for the event. Currently the schedule is through July and is subject to change if needed. ACBL National and District13 regional and sectional events are also included in the schedule.
- 5. Wednesday I/N Pairs
 - a. The layout is the same as Monday above, only with the Deals and Results for the Wednesday games.
