

Reopening Bridge

Special Games

Besides our regularly quarterly club championship games, the league granted in 2021 the in-person games: Two upgraded club championships (awarded when a club registers 10 new players with the league) awarding masterpoints:

81.8% sectional-rated black.

Eight regular club championships awarding masterpoints:

63.6% sectional rated black. This is the same as all other fund-raising games.

We are allowed to complete these this year. These must be for a week; they cannot be split. Then we have the same number of these for 2022 to be scattered over the remaining of this year.
