



Reopening Bridge in Review							

We reopened in-person games on May 3, 2021. So, let's look at the year in review. I didn't start tracking cases, positivity rate, and vaccinations until the end of June for a series of zipcodes along the lake from the loop north to Evanston. Estimating the geographical areas from a zip code map I took the zipcodes directly along the lakefront and then the zipcodes bordering on the lakefront zipcodes.

From these graphs we see that the number of new cases and the positivity rate is relatively flat until Holiday break started. We did not have enough tables registered, so the games were canceled during the Holiday Season.





This graph shows the number of tables for Monday and Wednesday of each week since we reopened. The lack of tables in August was due to Jerry falling and breaking his upper left arm and Phil's mother passing. There was a Chicago Regional in November and lack of registrants for a game on Thanksgiving eve.

Breakeven is the basic expenses for a game are rent, beverages, cookies, printing of handrecords, ACBL fees and any non-paying players, such as your directors playing to fill out a movement.
