When Is It Legal to Ask/Look

- When doing the following, there must not be the conveyance of unauthorized information.
 - Review of Auction:
 - Only at the player's first turn to call.
 - Just prior to the opening lead being faced.
 - After the above a player may ask what the contract is, but not who may have doubled it.
 - Method/Alert Explanations:
 - Only at own turn to call or play.
 - Just prior to the opening lead being faced.
 - Looking at Opponent's Convention Card:
 - Only at own turn to call/play
 - When it is Right Hand Opponent's turn to call
 - Looking at Own Convention Card:
 - Only between the end of the auction and before the opening lead is faced. This time is termed the Clarification Period.

Law 7 Control of Cards

- Removal of Cards from Board
 - Each player takes a hand from the pocket corresponding to his compass position.
 - Each player counts his cards face down to be sure he has exactly 13, and then he is to inspect the faces.
 - Failure to do so may result in the following penalties
 - Adjusted score
 - Revoke if card is found and restored to defective hand
 - During play each player retains the possession of his own cards, not permitting them to be mixed with those of any other player.
- Returning Cards to Board
 - After play has finished, i.e. after agreement of tricks won/lost; each player should shuffle the original 13 cards, and then restore the cards to the pocket corresponding to his compass direction.
